Brief Report

In observance of the International Day for the Conservation of the Mangrove Ecosystem on July 24, 2024, the Botany Association "Plures Plantae" of Mar Athanasius College (Autonomous), Kothamangalam in association with the Bhoomithrasena, Biodiversity club and Nature Club organized an educational field trip for second- and final-year B.Sc. Botany students to Mangalavanam Bird Sanctuary and the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI), Kochi. The visit to Mangalavanam Bird Sanctuary, often referred to as the "Green Lung of Kochi," provided students with first-hand exposure to the rich biodiversity of mangrove ecosystems. The field trip was an enriching experience, reinforcing the importance of mangrove conservation and marine ecosystem sustainability, while also enhancing the students' understanding of applied botany and environmental science.
